Anderson, his heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, fronting Club Street and known and designated as lot No. Forty (40) as shown in plat of the property entitled "Ableland Pass", as Recorded in Plat Book "E" at page 153 and has such course and dimensions as are shown on said plat, to which reference is made as a part of the description. This being the same lot of land as conveyed to us, the said Rudolf Anderson & Kenneth M. Geer, by S. K. Tindal, by her deed dated February 14th 1923, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office in and for Greenville County in Vol. 78 at page 514. It is understood and agreed by and between the Grantors and grantee that a five foot strip off the front of this property herein above described shall be deeded Greenville County for the purpose of making said street (Club Street) forty feet instead of thirty feet wide as shown at present.
