Russell, his heirs and assigns forever; All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and City Greenville Township, near the Monaghan Mills, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the line of Lots Nos. 9 and 10 on Smith Street and running thence with Smith Street S. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg. W. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a corner; thence N. 83 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg. W. 102 feet to a stake; thence N. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ deg. W. 27.2 feet to a corner; thence 101.5 feet to the beginning corner.
