made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, March 1922, recorded

more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe on West Coffee Street, joint
corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9 and running thence with
joint line of Lots Nos. 8 and 9, 21-44 E. 65 feet to a point
