Margaret Beverley Walker, all of my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half interest in and to: All that lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, at the Southeast corner of Cleveland Street and McDaniel Avenue, containing sixty-seven one hundredths (.67) of an acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds according to survey by W.A. Adams:

Beginning on iron pin, corner of Cleveland Street and McDaniel Avenue and running thence with McDaniel Avenue S. 4 W. one hundred and four feet to an iron pin; thence S. 85 E. three hundred and thirty feet to an iron pin on fifty foot street; thence with said Street N. 4 E. seventy-nine and one-half feet to an iron pin on Cleveland Street; thence with Cleveland Street N. 84 1/2 W. eighty-five feet to band; thence N. 77 1/2 W. two hundred and forty-five feet to beginning.
