Tract No. 5: Beginning on the Harrison Bridge Road at the corner of tract No. 1 and running thence along said road N. 73- $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 12.61 to stone; thence N. 15- $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 4.83 to stone; thence N. 73- $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 14.50 to a pin in road; thence along said road to center of branch at bridge; thence following said branch as a line along lands of Ben Evans and tracts Nos. 3 and 4 to stake on line of tract No. 1; thence along the line of tract No. 1 S. 16.25 E. 11.47 to the beginning corner, containing 40.14 acres, more or less;
