M. Coleman and Blanche Coleman for and during the minority of the said Herman Gaines Coleman and James Martin Coleman.

Tegether with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by me, as parent, over and in respect to the said Herman Gaines Coleman and James Martin Coleman. To have and to hold, the said Herman Gaines Celeman and James Martin Coleman,

against me and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest, right or privilege through me in and to the said Herman Gaines Coleman and James Martin Coleman. Previded, nevertheless, that under and by virtue of a decree in divorce granted by the Court of Wayne County, State of Michigan, in the case of James H. Coleman, vs. Vera G. Coleman, in which custody of the said Herman Gaines Coleman and James Martin Coleman was granted to the grantor, as father, and the further order of said Court, authorizing the transfer of said Herman Gaines Coleman and James Martin Coleman from the jurisdiction of the Court of Michigan to the State of South Carolina, and to place the same in the care of the said M. M. Coleman and Blanche Coleman, paternal grandparents, the mother of said Herman Gaines Coleman and James Martin Coleman is to have the privilege of seeing the said minors at reasonable times and places, but under no condition to be permitted to have the custody of said Herman Gaines Coleman and or James Martin Coleman.
