That, whereas, the contract of lease entered into between the said parties on er about the 22nd day of June, 1929, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for this County in Deed Book 147, at page 550, will of its ewn terms expire and end on July 12th, 1931; and it has been agreed between the said parties that the said contract of lease be renewed on the same terms and conditions, and with the same rights and privileges as therein set forth, except as herein set forth and changed, now, therefore, it is contracted and agreed by and between the said parties as follows:

That the First Parties, in consideration of the monthly rental of seventy five dollars per month, payable on the 12th day of each month from and after July 12th, 1931, do hereby lease and let to the said second parties the lot, buildings and all rights and privileges incident to and appertaining to the same, as set forth in the said original contract above mentioned, for a period of one year from July 12th, 1931; and further, the said first parties do hereby grant and give to the said second parties the right and option of a further renewal and extension of this agreement for one additional year from and after July 12th, 1952, at the said monthly rental of seventy five dollars, payable on the 12th day of each month during said renewal or extension hereof; but upon the condition that the said second parties shall give to the first parties notice of not less than thirty nor more than sixty days before the expiration date of this agreement, to-wit: July 12th, 1932, notice of their intention to so renew and continue this contract of force and effect. Upon the failure to give the said notice, and in the absence of any other or further agreement entered into between the said parties with relation thereto, this contract will automatically of its own terms expire and terminate on the date of July 18th, 1932...

This contract, and any renewals and extensions hereof, to be and is hereby made binding upon, and enure to the benefit of, the respective parties hereof, their respective heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, as to all the terms and conditions of the eriginal contract heretofore entered into, and this renewal of the same as well.

Any additions to or changes in this agreement to be reduced to writing and signed by the parties hereto, their respective representatives or assigns.
