## Lease of Petroleum Vending Privileges, (Mental Determined by Sales)

This Agreement, made this 1st day of January in the year 1981, by and between Seuthern Wersted Corporation, hereinafter called Lesser, and Standard Oil Company of New Jersey, hereinafter called Lessee.

Witnesseth: Leaser dees hereby denise and lease unto Leasee the exclusive right to stere and sell gaseline, meter fuels, grease and other petroleum products, all of which are hereinafter referred to collectively as Petroleum Products, except Standard Noter oil lüssee delivers for Nutual Petroleum Co's account during the year 1931, on the premises in the Town of Paris Geunty of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

One let of land situated in the above County and State, extending twenty five (25) feet north, thomas twenty five (25) feet east, thence twenty five (25) feet west, and thence twenty five (25) feet south back to beginning point; all on the property of Southern Wersted Corporation.

Lessee shall have the exclusive right and privilege of maintaining and using pumpe, tanks and other facilities for the storage, sale and delivery of petroleum products and the servicing of automobiles at the places on said promises where pumps, tanks and other facilities are new located on said promises. Lessee shall also have the exclusive use and eccupancy of an effice and storage space 10 feet long and 10 feet wide, located at the front of the building on the promises herein described. Lessee shall also have the exclusive use and possession of the machinery, tools, furniture and appliances which are listed in the schedule herete attached and marked Schedule A, Lessee, its employees, agents, oustomers and these having business with it shall have full, free, find unrestricted ingrees to, egress from and access to and use of all of the spaces and facilities hereby leased to Lessee.

To held the promises hereby demised unto Lessee for the period of 1 years beginning on the 1st day of January 1931 and ending on the 51st day of Jacomber 1931, Lessee paying therefor as rental each menth an amount equivalent to one cent for each gallen of gaseline and other motor fuels seld during the mouth at said promises by Lessee, its agents or assigns. Payments of said rental are to be made on or before the tenth day of the menth following the menth in which the rental is earned. Lessee shall keep such books and records as will assurately show the number of gallens of gaseline and other meter fuels sold at the demised premises and will permit Lessey to examine and inspect such books and records at any time and from time to time when Lesser desires so to de.

The above letting is on the fellowing terms, conditions and covenants, to wit:

- 1. Lesser will not store or sell or permit anyone other than Lesses and its employees agents or assigns to store or sell any petroleum products of any kind whatsoever at the premises herein described or in the streets adjacent thereto.
  - 2. Lesses shall pay the specified rent at the times and in the manner provided.
- 5. Lesser agrees to pay all taxes and assessments now or hereafter levied against said premises. Should lesser fail to pay such taxes or assessments when due and payable, Lesses shall have the right to pay the same and may withheld from any rentals payable hereunder as they accrue, such amounts as may be necessary to fully reimburse Lesses.
- 4. Lessec may install, move and remove at and from the premises hereby leased to it such tanks, pipes, pumps, equipment, machinery and other facilities for the stering, handling, and selling of petroleum products, and servicing automobiles as shall in its epinion be necessarin erder to use said premises for its business of storing, handling and selling of petroleum products. Lessee may paint the tanks, pumps, machinery and other equipment installed or operate by it, and may paint the buildings on the premises herein described inany colors it shall elect, and to paint thereon any of its trade marks and other signs, devices and advertisements.
- 5. Upon the expiration or termination of this lease for any cause, Leasee is to return the property described in Schedule A, herete attached to Leaser and Leasee shall restore said premises to the condition existing on the date, hereof, crimary wear and tear excepted. Leasee shall have too right to remove from said premises all tanks, pumps, pipes, equipment, machinery and other facilities placed thereon by Leasee.
- 6. In case the premises are rendered unfit for eccupancy by fire, sterm, explosion or any other cause, no rental shall accrue or is to be paid from the beginning, of such unfitness for eccupancy until the premises are put in tenantable condition and Lossee is able to and does eccupy said premises for the purposes herein described.
- 7. Lesses during the term of this lease or any removal or extension thereof shall have the right and privilege to sublet or assign all or any part of its right under and to said premises, but any such subletting or assignment shall not relieve Lesses from its obligation to pay the rout herein reserved unless Lesser shall comsent in writing to such subletting or assignment.

- 9. Lessee has and is hereby given the right to cancel this lease at any time on giving Lesser thirty days' notice of Lessee's intention so to do.
- 10. Any notice to be given by Lesses to Lesser shall be sufficiently given if in writing and delivered to Lesser or mailed, postage propaid, to Lesser at the premises herein described or at such other address as may at any time be furnished by Lesser to Lesses.
