 County of Greenville in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, known and designated as lot no 4 on a plat copied by J. E. Birrine from a Survey made by Joe P. Lawrence April 15, 1909 showing J. E. Beallie's Buncombe Street property and having the following meters and bounds beginning at a stake on Whitney Street approximately 182 feet 5 inches from the property line on Buncombe Street. Said stake being on the corner of a nine foot alley and running thence along said Whitney Street in the direction of Sampson Avenue, 60 feet to a stake on the corner of lot no 5 on said plat; thence along line of lot mentioned lot in the direction of Main Street 180 feet to a place on line of lot, belonging now or formerly to the Estate of G. G. Miles deceased, thence along the Miles line, in the direction of Buncombe Street 20 feet and 4 inches, to a stake on corner of lot no 5 on said plat set apart to Emily St. Beallie under the Will of J. E. Beallie, deceased; thence along line of lot mentioned lot and parallel with Buncombe Street and in the direction of Whitney Street, 63 feet to a stake on the corner of the alley above mentioned; thence along line of said Alley and parallel with the rear line of lot no 2 on said plat 34 feet, 7 inches to a stake thence along said alley, parallel with the rear line of lot no 1 on said plat 65 feet, 3 inches to the beginning corner on Whitney Street.
