And forever quit claim unto Mrs. Ellie Rose, her heirs and assigns, all of its right, title and interest in, in and to, all that tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining to J. W. Sullivan, Fork Shoals Baptist Church and others containing five and four tenths acres, more or less, beginning at a T.L. on Fork Shoals Road (also church corner) thence S 62° 50' E 9.00 to a stone on said road; thence N 5° 26' 1.16 to a stone on said road; thence N 83° 54' 3.13 to corner; thence S 30° 21' 3.10 to cedar tree; thence S 27° 51' 12 to the beginning.

Also all that other tract adjoining the above containing 13.90 acres, more or less, beginning at a factory stamp on J. W.
