a corporation created under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business in Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and no/100 Dollars. DOLLARS.

I, the undersigned, do hereby and do make and execute the within and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named, to witness whereof a letter acknowledged in writing, deposited and not tendered and of these presents are given witness and my true name.

Wm. Phoebeo Shipe, his heirs and assigns forever.

All that certain place, part or lot of land situate, lying and being in Madison Township, County and State aforesaid, containing thirty acres (30) and being Lot No. 1 of a Sub-division of the Prince Place made by S. A. Ellis Surveyor, March 20th, 1881, with the following bounds and more or less:

Beginning at Stake on Anderson Line, thence S. 57¹/₂ E. 26.00 to Stake on Saluda River, thence up the river to Stake, thence N. 57¹/₂ E. 29.10 to Stake on Anderson Line, thence S. 57¹/₂ E. 11.30 to the beginning corner. This lot being part of tract of land granted to Chiocca Bank February 1st, 1882, by L. T. Jones containing 114 acres, and recorded in Book "B", at page 250, L. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
