to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto J. Mark Smith, the following described property:

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the waters of Silder Creek, branch waters of Enoree River, containing fifty-seven (57.0) acres, more or less: Beginning at an old corner on the public road leading from Bethel Church by Daniel Holland, and in a N.
