to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto *Bright P. Carson*

All that certain piece, parcel or strip of land lying and being situated in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, S.C. at the intersection of Hitchcock and Spartanburg Streets, and lying immediately at the rear of the lot above owned by Bright P. M. In said first Ward of and contiguous to the strip of land herein conveyed to her by the grantor as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 154, Page 124, R. W. C office for Greenville County, the strip herein conveyed being there particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the front side of Hitchcock Street, the present front most corner of the Bright P. M. In lot, which iron pin is on the gentleman line or line of Lot 100, 10 and 12 feet south of the northeast corner, and running thence with the present rear line of the lot of Bright P. M. In 8. 36 P.D.C. 33 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 63-06 E. 33 feet to another iron pin; thence S. 16-34 E. 20.7 feet to another iron pin, the present northeast corner of the lot of Bright P. M. In on Spartanburg Street, and running thence N. 67-42 W. 32.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-38 to 51.4 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

This being a portion of the said end of Hitchcock Street and a small portion of Spartanburg Street as now located, and the conveyance is being made for the purpose of readjusting the rear line of the said Bright P. M. In accordance with a plan prepared by Watson and Nease, Engineers, on October 3, 1930.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
