KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

*J. C. Jones Company*a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of *South Carolina*, and having its principal place of business at *Greenville*, in the State of *South Carolina*, for and in consideration of the sum of *One thousand four hundred* DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

*Main Street Realty Corporation*

All that piece of land or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the west side of North Main Street in said City, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances as per plat by J. E. Service, dated January 22, 1920:

Beginning at a point on said street at center of party wall of said property with Beattie Building and running thence along Main Street North 18° East 42.03' to corner of brick wall between stores now occupied by R. L. McGehee Company and Raynor's Castle, thence along the center of said brick wall North 72° 42' west 121.81' to line of property of Moore, thence along said line South 19° 50' west 41.51' to center line party wall of Beattie Building, thence along said center line of said party walls South 72° 27' East 122.50' to the beginning point on Main Street, being same lot of land conveyed to J. C. Jones by James M. Anderson, in deed dated February 2nd, 1920, recorded in Vol. 66 page 482, R. M. Office for Greenville County.

It is understood and agreed that the grantee herein by accepting this deed does not assume payments of either of the above mortgages.

The property herein described by the grantee, conveyed to J. C. Jones Company by J. C. Jones by deed dated May 1, 1932, recorded in this office in Book 82, at page 57.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and *its successors* heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and *its successors* heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Jones, President* and *G. Heyward Melton Jr., Vice President* on this the *May* day of *May* in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and *thirty three* and in the one hundred and fifth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
