WHEREAS, Michel Shahid, Fred Shahid, and Kelley Shahid, all of Greenville, S.C.

did on the 4th day of September, 1935, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given. SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Dime Taxi, Inc. THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S.C.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is ten (10) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars

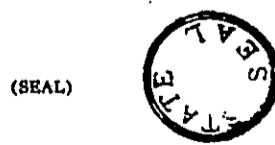

EIGHT: That subsequently there was elected as President Michel Shahid, as Vice-President Fred Shahid, as Secretary, Kelly Shahid, as Treasurer, Michel Shahid

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter 153, Article 2 of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville County, S.C. Greenville
