 Greenville Court House on the old Cox bridge  
 road, about one quarter of a mile from the white  
 house road, having the following meters and  
 bounds to wit, beginning at a chickory in  
 the base line and running thence N. 56 1/4 E.  
11.2 chains to a stone on corner of Mrs.  
Lyons open land, thence along line of Lyons  
land, thence along line of Lyons land, N. 11 1/4 W.  
22.5 chains to stone which was kept to the  
 corner of the French, and Howard lands;  
 thence N. 72 1/2 W. 7.96 chains to a stone on
