Beatty, in Trustee of the School District of the City of Spartanburg, and their successors and assigns, a tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and containing 1/2 acre, more or less, bounded on the north side by Rutherford Street, on the east by Goodlett Street, on the south by Leathers Street, and on the west by Leathers Street, and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat thereof made by Baldwin & Nease bearing date November 1927, to-wit: Beginning at a corner pipe on the north side of Rutherford Street two hundred, thirty-one (231) feet westward running to Leathers Street, the corner of land belonging to J. A. Leathers and running the same along Leathers Street one hundred, forty-four (144) feet to a corner of land belonging to the grantor of said pipe, being one hundred sixteen (116) feet from Goodlett Street; thence along other land of this grantor 47' 36 1/4" (less ^{1/4} of a rod) feet to pipe on corner of land belonging to George W.
