town of Fountain Inn on the west side of Main street,

at right angle to Main street 43 feet & inches to C. & W. C.
right of way; thence along said right of way in a northerly
direction 33 feet, and 7 inches to a corner on the C. & W. C. right

47 feet 6 inches to Main street; thence along Main street
