James Henry Smith, all that aright or land, in the above
summed number and state, and having the
following metes and bounds, beginning at the corner to
the tract in C. Smith and my other D. Sister, and running
from S. 57 E. 35. 07 ran thence along the line to S.
D. Sister's Land S. 57 E. 35. 07 ran, thence S. 61 E. 44. 04 back
thence S. 22 E. 56. 01 ran to the beginning corner being known
as first in S. 43 the aforesaid tract of land, and
being described in area of a million acres, including the
part S. 57 E. 35. 07 in town, running in S. 61 E. 44. 04
and returning about one acre of
land between S. 57 E. 35. 07 and S. 61 E. 44. 04
and running about one acre of
land between S. 57 E. 35. 07 and S. 61 E. 44. 04
