East Main Street, near the City of Greenville,
South Carolina, as follows: lot 37, and 38, as
shown on a plat of the City of Greenville,
in the City of Greenville, County, South Carolina,
in Book 1, page 2, and relating
to said lot, the following lines and boundaries, to wit:
beginning at an iron post on the north side of
Main Street, just corner of lots 37 & 38 and run-
ning thence with Main Street N. 58-30 E. 100 feet
to an iron post corner of lots Nos. 39 and 38;
then with line N. 58-30 E. 100 feet
to an iron post thence with line of lots Nos. 39 and
40 E. 100 feet to an iron post thence along
with line of lots Nos. 38 and 36, S. 81-39 E. 100 feet
