adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be conveyed by

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman  
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,  
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

W. J. Black, his heirs and assigns forever, all  
the right, title and interest of Gladys Hart,  
Eugene Hart and Rosabelle Hart (now and to  
the following described real estate:  
"All certain certain piece, parcel or tract of land  
situate lying and being in State of South Carolina, County of Greenville on  
waters of Elbert River containing 67 1/2 acres,  
more or less, adjoining lands of R. J. Davis  
to the west; Esopie Clark and J. J.  
Stylor to the north; J. C. Stylor on the east;  
Judy Curriath's land on the south, and being  
particularly described as beginning at a stone  
at road, 25 feet right of way, and the  
length of corner, 1011 E. 1035 to Black gum,  
thence 1035 north 1035 to Caplan, thence N. 20 W.  
218 to O. P. Thence N. 43 1/2 E., 153 1/2 to stone thence  
N. 47 E. 20.22 to O. P. on bank of Elbert River, thence  
thence 11 W. 110 to O. P. thence along Elbert River  
road 110 to O. P. thence S. 10 1/2 E. 56 links;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said W. J. Black  
and his heirs and assigns forever.
