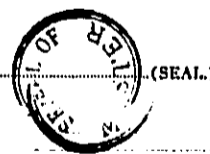
heirs and assigns, in and to certain parcel and  
part of a tract of land being in South Carolina, Greenville  
County, in the City of Greenville, and on the  
North side of Second Street, having the following  
description to-wit:  
Beginning at the point of the intersection of  
the North West corner of James and David Streets, and  
running easterly along James Street a distance of 100  
feet to the North West corner of the same; thence  
North 142 ft. 11 in. more or less; thence in a  
straight line with a line of a lot now or formerly  
owned by R. H. Price 60 ft. to a point, same being the  
corner of the lot above described by me to C. L. Hilton;  
thence in a southerly direction with Hilton's line  
and parallel with David Street, 147 ft. and in more  
or less to a point on James Street, the point and  
place of which beginning.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from under, or any of them.
