N. Southern, recorded in the R. M. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book II, at Page 649"

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said C. L. Kelly and his heirs and assigns forever.
