all that certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Glassy Mountain Township, on head waters of Brushy Creek, waters of North Broad River, containing 50 acres more or less beginning on a regular 30 x 30 - thence down said creek to the higher hills of Phillips Ward's line nearly south to a chestnut oak; thence nearly S. to a blazed oak; thence to a blazed oak; thence nearly east to a blazed hickory; thence to a blazed oak; thence to a blazed white oak; thence to a chestnut on a cliff of rock 30 and 20 m; thence nearly north to a blazed chestnut thence to a regular blazed; thence to a blazed chestnut; thence to the beginning corner."
