(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. Ed. Bridgeman, his heirs and assigns,  
all his joint and several interest  
as heir at law and distributee of J. T. Bridgeman,  
holder of the property aforesaid, of me and to all  
that lot of land situate and the Spartanburg-  
Greenville highway in the State and County a-  
foreaid and described as follows:

Beginning at a stone marker on the north side  
of said highway and running thence N. 42° 6' 23  
feet to a stake, thence N. 67° 53' W. 351 feet to a stake  
at the corner of the lot of Amanda Russell;  
thence S. 16° 26' 38" E. 111 to a wooden post on the  
north side of said highway, thence along  
said highway S. 57° 40' E. 167 feet to the begin-  
ning corner containing 2.3 acres more or less  
according to the survey of A. A. Merrick, dated

March 22, 1929.
