on plat, recorded in G. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Plat Book 2, at page 197, and having
according to said plat the following metes and
bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern line
of State Avenue, joint corner of lots nos 22 and
23, and running thence with a point line of said
lot N. 0° 43' E. 175 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of
lots nos 22 and 23, thence N. 28° 58' E. 52 feet to an
iron pin in line of lot no 19; thence along the rear
lines of lots nos 19, 20 and 21 S. 0° 48' E. 175 feet to an
iron pin on northern line of State Avenue; thence
with line of said State Avenue S. 28° 58' E. 52 feet to
the point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said B. B. Smith, his
Heirs and Assigns forever, subject, however, to the following restrictions which are expressly made for the benefit of
all persons who now own or may hereafter acquire the same,
or shall plant to plant the said property to be used exclusively
for residential purposes. (1) No building of any kind shall be
erected nearer to State Avenue than 30 feet. (2) The property herein
conveyed shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed to any
person or persons having any percentage of negro blood. (3) No
dwelling shall be erected on said property costing less than
Twenty-seven Hundred (\$2700.00) Dollars. (This shall not apply
to out buildings appurtenant to a dwelling)

AND we ourselves and our do hereby bind
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

B. B. Smith, his

heirs and assigns, against
ourselves and our
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
