Norwood, the following described real estate: All that tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, in Paris Mountain Township, on East side of Cooper's Creek, waters of Saluda River, and bounded by lands now or formerly of Isaac Edwards, J. S. Blakely, Hodgens and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to J. S. Garlington, Jr. and L. C. Garlington by C.
