the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

American Building and Loan Association, a corporation, the following described real estate:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in a subdivision known as Overbrook, near Overbrook depot of the Southern Public Utilities Company car line, and being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 1 on plat for property of Hunt, Norwood & Todd, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, in April, 1917, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin, corner of right of way of Overbrook car line and a street, and running thence with said Street S. 44-19 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 45-11 W. 98-75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 77 W. 49.6 feet to an iron pin in the line of lot No. 14; thence with the line of said Lot No. 14, N. 27-42 W. 40 feet to an iron pin on the right of way of the Overbrook car line; thence along said right of way N. 49-28 E. 62 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said right of way N. 44-48 E. 68 feet to the beginning corner, being a portion of one of the lots of land conveyed to L.
