all that piece, parcel or lot of land in _____ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the north side of the Laurens Road about two miles from the City of Greenville. Beginning at a rock 34 and running thence N. 62 E. 15.00 to a stone 32; thence S. 38 1/2 E. 4.88 to a stone 34; thence N. 62 E. 18.50 to a stone 32; thence S. 25 E. 6.02 to a stone; thence S. 66 3/4 W. 29.75 to a stone on the Laurens Road; thence along said Laurens Road N. 57 1/2 W. 9.00 to the beginning corner, containing twenty-one acres, more or less. Lias a twenty-foot street on the west side running from the Laurens Road, to the place now or formerly owned by G. J. Hopkins.
