do pay to May Birnie Alston Jordan,

in the State aforesaid, the record wherein is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said May Birnie Alston Jordan,

the said piece, part or all of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

being known and designated as Lot No. 14, of the property of May B. Lewis, as shown on Plat recorded in Plat Book "P", page 156, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Aberdeen Avenue, joint corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 13, N. 62-50 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 27-10 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-50 E. 180 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Aberdeen Avenue; thence with Aberdeen Avenue S. 27-10 E. 70 feet to the beginning. Being the same conveyed to me by Thos. L. Lewis by deed dated July 29, 1826, and recorded in Deed Book 113, page 114, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

Nevertheless upon the following conditions, which conditions are part of the consideration for this deed and are expressly for the benefit of all owners of lots as shown on Plat above referred to, to-wit:

1. No building shall be erected nearer to the abutting sidewalk than 35 feet.
2. The property herein conveyed shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed to a person or persons having any percentage of negro blood.
3. The property herein conveyed shall never be used for other than residential purposes, and no residence costing less than \$4,000.00 shall be erected thereon.
