thence S. 41 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 14.99 chains to an iron pin in edge of Wood  
land, thence S. 45 W. 8.64 chains to iron pin on each side of  
Bellamy Road, thence S. 17 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 4.71 chains to iron pin on J. P.  
Green line, thence N. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 19.14 chains to stone on Henry Smith
