(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Benjamin F. Durdle and Paula Belle Durdle, their heirs and assigns,

All that lot of land situate in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, about (3 1/2) acres land one half miles East of Greenville County Courthouse near the Spartanburg Road and designated as lot #64 of the subdivision of Eastlake as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book, 65, page 239 and showing the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Chest Uncle Avenue, 239.3 feet from the intersection of the Spartanburg Road and Chest Uncle Avenue and running thence with Chest Uncle Avenue S 37° 26' E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots #64 and #65; thence with joint line of lots #64 and #65 S 52° 40' E. 182.7 feet to a point, thence N 37° 26' E. 60 feet to a point, joint corner of lots #63 and #64; thence with line as lots #63 and #64 N 52° 40' E. 182.7 feet to the beginning.

This being a part of a tract of thirty six (36) acres of land, surveyed to J.
