(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. P. Chamberlain,

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situate in the County of Greenville, State of
South Carolina, in Calabash Township, about
11 1/2 miles North of the City of Greenville, S.C., on
a road leading off from the Augusta Road,
and having the following Survey and Boundaries,
according to a plat and survey made by J. A. Ellis
Surveyor, on Nov. 24, 1924, and recorded in the
Office of the Clerk for Greenville County, S.C. in plat
Book #8 page 275. Beginning at a Stake in the
center of said new road, at a point 30 chains
east of the Augusta Road, and a corner of said
V. King land, and running thence N. 61° 15' E. with
said new road, 16 7/8 chains to a stake thence
N. 15° 35' E. 18 chains to a stake thence N. 85° 20'
W. 2.04 chains to an iron post, thence N. 68° 30' W. 2.03
chains to more post, thence S. 60° 45' W. 2.02 chains
to corner of said V. King property, thence with his
line S. 28° 17' E. 14.95 chains to the beginning corner,
containing 39.77 acres, more or less. Being a
portion of the same tract of land conveyed to the
Bank of Commerce by C. L. Murray, Master by
Deed dated Jan. 3, 1925, recorded in the R. R. C. Office
for Greenville County, S.C. in Vol. 94 page 203.

Together with the right of agreed and
inches to, over and along the said new road
from the Augusta Road to the premises herein
conveyed, and which is shown on the plat above
referred to.

This deed is made in performance to the
Authority vested in me by order of Court,
of record, Clerk's Office, Greenville County, S.C.

It is understood that the grantor is paying
all taxes for the year 1930, and is to have possession
of said premises until Jan. 1, 1931, but the
granted is hereby granted the right to go upon said
premises at any time after October 15, 1930, for
the purpose of erecting a building thereon
provided in so doing paid grantee shall not
occupy more than one acre of said premises.
