M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin rear corner of lots nos. 28 and 27, and running thence S. 86-42 W. 50 feet to an iron pin on western line of lot No. 29; thence S. 11-18 E. 50 feet with western line of lot No. 29 to an iron pin in Charles Street; thence N. 86-42 E. 50 feet to an iron pin on Charles Street on southern line of lot No. 29; thence N. 11-18 W. 50 feet on rear of lot No. 28, to the beginning corner.
