Jess G. Mullinax and Bertha Mullinax
all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situate, lying and being in the State and County
aforecaid, O'Neal Township, about six miles northwest
of Greenville, on the north side of the Buncombe Road,
adjoining lands of Ford Bruce, Earle Duncan, and
others, and being a part of three tracts of land
known as the Stuart lands, the Raines lands and
the Davenport lands, and having the following
metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:
Beginning in the center of the Buncombe
Road, Ford Bruce's corner and run thence
with the said road S. 42-20 E. 495 feet to a point
in the center of said road; thence N. 35-50 E.
695 feet to a Post oak 3 X N.M. on the east side
of a community road; thence with the community
road N. 34-53 E. 745 feet to bend; thence N. 70-06
E. 100 feet to bend; thence N. 64-20 E. 300 feet, to
bend thence N. 54-30 E. 368.2 feet to bend;
thence N. 18-10 E. 400 feet to bend, thence N. 55-30 E.
241.5 feet to a point on Earle Duncan's line,
which is 134.5 feet from Joe Williams corner;
thence with the Duncan's line N. 65-05 W. 960
feet to stone on branch; thence S. 27-10 W. 1149.7
feet to a stone; thence S. 65-05 E. 139 feet to a
stone; thence S. 36-55 W. 960.3 feet to a stone;
thence S. 58-45 W. 400 feet to the beginning corner,
containing Thirty four and four one hundredths
(34.04) acres, more or less.
