\$1.00 Received of Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Co. Incorporated, One & 20/100 dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own or in which I have any interest, in the 1 of 1 County of Greenville and State of S.C. and upon and along the roads, streets or highways adjoining the said property, said sum is received in full payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to trim and cut trees along said lines so far to clear and keep the wires cleared at least 36 inches and the further right to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto and to trim the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor.

The Telephone Company agrees to relocate to stub and anchor on said property, to accommodate future roads, street improvements and the construction of building
