HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

J. A. Reaves and J. P. Reaves

"All that certain tract of land in Dunklin Township, County and State
aforesaid, containing 232 acres, more or less, and known and designated as Tract No. 3,
according to a subdivision and plat of the estate of Jesse L. French, made by Dalton &
Neves, Engineers, in April, 1930, Said tract of land is bounded by lands of B.F. Martin
E. W. Carpenter, Ware Shoals Mfg. Co. Davenport, Burton, and Tracts Nos. 1, 2 and 5,
of the plat above mentioned and has such metes and bounds and courses and distances,
as will appear by reference to the above plat, which is of record in the R.M.C. office
for the County and State aforesaid in Plat Book "G", Page 270."

The above tract of land represents the divided interest of D. C. French,
as fixed by the Court, in the Partition Suit herein, under which this deed is made.
