HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said
Morris Campell, Leon Campell and Rebecca Campell.

All the right, title and interest and Mrs. Rosina Campell, and Annie Campell, Sarah
Campell, Clara Campell and Solomon Campell, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of
land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being on
the corner of Stone Ave. and Wilton street, in the City of Greenville, and being known
and designated as lot No. 1 as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Green-
ville County in Plat Book "A", at page 89, and having the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

Beginning at the corner of Stone Ave. and Wilton Street and running thence S. 5 1/2
W. 155 feet to corner; thence N. 87 W. 57 feet to corner of lot formerly owned by A. T.
Munn; thence along line of said lot N. 5 1/2 E. 158 feet to Stone Ave.; thence along Stone
Ave. S. 84 1/2 E. 61 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to
