M. L. Littlefield, the following described real estate;

"All that certain lot of land, containing the residence of the said late L. H. Littlefield, in the town of Greer, said County and State, on the North side of Pelham Street, and beginning at an iron spike, D. D. Davenport's corner, and runs thence N. 55 1/2 W. 1.60 chs. to a stake on the west side of Mills Street; thence S. 16 1/2 E. 5.91 chs. to the center of Pelham Road; thence N. 33 3/4 E. 4.05 feet to an iron pin NM; thence N. 54 3/4 W. 29 links to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to L. H. Littlefield by I. M. Wood by deed recorded in Vol. 17, Page 366."
