County Court of Greenville for the County aforesaid, against Eugene N. Gallamore, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 5th  
day of June 1937, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was  
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W. C. Norris and Lula Norris

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-6452)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman  
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

W. C. Norris and Lula Norris

All the right title and interest of Eugene N. Gallamore  
the same being an undivided two-thirds interest, in  
and to the following described real estate.

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris  
Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South  
Carolina, and designated as Tract No. 4 of the Nancy  
Roberts Place, recorded in Plat. Book A, page 167, P.  
M. C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina,  
containing 10 acres, more or less, adjoining lands of  
Pinson Pike, Mrs. Lee, et al.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in  
the State and County aforesaid being Lot No. 3 of a  
survey of John S. Gureton, D. C. October 16, 1906, of the  
Killer Roberts Tracts, situate about three miles from  
the City of Greenville in Greenville County, containing  
14.357100 acres, more or less, and more particularly  
described as follows: Beginning at a stone on the  
southeast corner of Lot No. 3 at the junction of Lots  
Nos. 2, 3, 7 and 6, N. 22 E. 3.10 chains to a stone,  
thence N. 57. 1/2 W. 14.80 chains to stone, thence N. 61 1/2  
W. 6.70 chains to a stone, thence S. 7 1/2 W. 11.00 chains  
to a stone, thence S. 82 E. 19.00 chains to the beginning  
corner, being the same lot conveyed to R. N. Gallamore  
by W. H. Sinnett Feb. 6, 1917, and recorded in Vol. 46,  
Page 93, P. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South  
Carolina."
