demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th
day of September 19 37, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Greenville Airport Commission

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 4-6675)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Greenville Airport
Commission

"All that lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina
about three miles east of Greenville Court House, known as Lots Nos. 2 and 3 on plat made
by W. J. Ridgely, April, 1931, recorded in office of R. M. C. for said County in Plat Book H,
Page 189, and having the following courses and distances according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on road to Wood's lake, corner of land of J. P. Cosgrove and
running thence with his line and land of Hortense Walker 1253 feet to stone, corner of
Gertrude Smith; thence with line of lot conveyed by David W. Wood to John H. Honour and his
Children N. 16 E. 1021 feet to iron pin on Wood's Lake Road; thence with said road N.
85 W. 117 feet; thence N. 84-10 W. 442 feet to the beginning. Said lots contain in the
aggregate 6.39 acres, more or less."

Dollars and is to be paid direct by the purchaser as provided for the Decree of Court
herein.
