and quitclaim in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said W. B. Allen

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, and on the East side of the Buncombe Road and being known and designated as tract no. 6 according to a sub-division and plat of the lands of J. C. Allen's estate made by B. F. Nevels surveyor, July 15th, 1915 and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point in the Buncombe Road at the corner of tract No. one (1) in the sub-division of the J. C. Allen estate and running thence in a southeasterly direction along said Buncombe Road 12.94 to a point in said road thence N. 22 E. 2.50 to White Oak; thence N. 49 E. 10.60 to Maple; thence N. 39 E. 7.80 to a stone; thence N. 69 W. 11.00 to a large rock; thence S. 10 E. 8 to stone xom. thence S. 88 W. 10.85 to the beginning corner containing 13 1/2 acres.
