D. H. Thompson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Dunklin Township, county and state aforesaid and being more fully described as follows: Beginning at a stone on south side of Dunklin Bridge road and running thence N. 87 1/2 W. 488 ft. to an iron pin in center of said road, thence N. 2520 E. 726 ft. to a stone, thence N. 33-45 E. 324 ft. to a stone; thence N. 3015 E. 557 ft. to a stone; thence N. 43 1/2 E. 539 ft. to a stone; thence N. 41-30 E. 257 ft. to a stone thence N. 35-15 E. 163 ft. to a stone; thence N. 17 E. 450 ft. to a stone; thence N. 44-15 E. 243 ft. to a blackgum corner of Cemetery lot, thence along line of Cemetery Lot, S. 12-45 E. 209 ft. to a stone; thence further along line of Cemetery lot N. 83 E. 122 ft. to a stone; thence S. 24-45 E. 432 ft. to a stone on old line, thence S. 86 W. 143 ft. to a stone; thence S. 9 W. 307 ft. to a stone, thence S. 54 W. 641 ft. to a stone, thence S. 25-15 W. 1461 ft. to the beginning corner and containing thirty acres, more or less, after excluding a right of way thirty feet wide along the three last mentioned lines, which is to be used as a road to the Cemetery.
