Whereas the undersigned L. A. Vaughn, was heretofore appointed by the Probate Court for said County and State Guardian of the then minors Horace White, Frank White, and Edna White;

And whereas, in the course of the administration of said estates it became necessary to foreclose a mortgage that was owned by said estates on the land hereinafter described and the same was bid in by the Guardian at the sum of Twenty-four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars for said estates.

And whereas, the said Horace White and Frank White have reached their majority and after due advertisement for final settlement and discharge, as their Guardian, the said L. A. Vaughn was by decree of the Probate Court so discharged, on or about the 25th day of July, 1931, and in the decree thereto concerning it was adjudged that as a part of the settlement with the said Horace White and Frank White the Guardian should convey to each of them an undivided one third interest in
