promised, other than is herein specified, have remised, released and forever discharged, and do hereby for myself, my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, remise, release and forever discharge the said National Utilities Company of South Carolina, its Successors and Assigns, of and from all claims and demands, actions and causes of action, damages, costs, expenses and compensation on account of or in any way growing out of, resulting, or to result from the erection, construction and maintenance of the dam of the said National Utilities Company across Reedy River in Laurens County at or near Tumbling Shoals, and all issues involved in the suit of the said Joe M. Chandler, Plaintiff vs. National utilities Company hereinbefore described; provided, however, that this settlement and release is based upon the height and condition of said dam at the present time, and if the same should be raised and the area of the pond increased, any damage to said lands resulting or to result therefrom is not included in the settlement aforesaid or in anywise released by this instrument.
