

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, a corporation of South Carolina all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

West of the City of Greenville, between Woodside and Brandon Cotton Mills fronting sixty (60) feet on Woodside Avenue, with a depth of One Hundred Fifty (150) feet, said lot being made up of Lot no 11 and 18 feet off of lot no 12 adjoining, of the Bonwood property plat of which property is recorded in Plat Book 2, page 1463.

Also all that other certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining the above described lot of land, having a frontage of (90) feet on Woodside Avenue, and a depth of one hundred fifty (150) feet, being all of lot no 13 and forty feet of lot no 12 as shown on above mentioned plat.
