thence S. 60° 45' E. 38.6 feet, thence S. 22° 40' W. 50 feet to a stake; thence N. 70° 45' W.
41 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to E. L. Goddard by
Martha L. Goddard by deed dated February 11, 1920, recorded in the A.M.C. Office for
