

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. J. Poate allsoe eight, title and interests in the several lots of Lot 36 and 37 in the Woodlawn Addition in all those certain places aforesaid in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville in the subdivision known and designated as Woodlawn Heights, being known as Lots 36 and 37 of said subdivision according to plan made by J. H. Southern Surveyor, on October 9, 1906, and recorded in the M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Book 10 page 133. The said two lots each have a frontage of 50 feet on South Street, with a depth of 150 feet, and being the same lots conveyed by J. H. Nettie by W. M. Nettie and by deed of record in Volume 10 page 16 and 28, page 604, respectively.

The grantors herein are the sole heirs at law and distributees of J. H. Nettie, deceased, who died intestate, owning no other land, and no other property. It is understood and agreed that the note and mortgage bearing date February 4, 1928, mortgage recorded in Mortgage Book 149 page 21, R. W. C. Office for said Greenville County, shall remain in trust for the benefit of the grantee, to protect his title to this land, and shall not merger. This deed, however, is absolute in intent as well as form, and the grantee has full power and right to convey the same to the grantee.
