Beginning at an iron pin on O'Neal Street and running S. 7 1/2 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 82 3/4 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N 7 1/2 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on O'Neal Street; thence with O'Neal Street N. 82 3/4 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
