Over the City of Greenville, being lot number twenty of the subdivision known as Morgan Hill, plot of which is recorded in the office of Register of Deeds, to appearance, for Greenville County, bearing the following metes and bounds:

Begins being at an iron pin on O'Neal Street and running S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 200 feet to an iron pin, thence S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 40 feet to an iron pin, thence N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 36.200 feet to an iron pin on O'Neal Street, thence 20 feet S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 60 feet to the beginning point.
